Matters arising from the last meeting

- Progress of ongoing renewal of the school curriculum and the resumption of the CDC Standing Committees were reported.

The revised the Mathematics curriculum (P1 – S6)

- The revised Mathematics curriculum and the feedback collected were reported.
- Members discussed and offered final comments on the revised curriculum, including the need to raise students' interest in learning Mathematics and highlight the importance of Extended Part Module 1/Module 2 (M1/M2), the school timetabling of M1/M2, and the implementation of the curriculum.

- Feedback collected on the major updates was reported.

- Feedback collected on the major updates was reported.
