

CDC Committee on Mathematics Education (2019-2021)

Gist of the First Meeting

Date: 3 December 2019 (Tuesday)

Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. Members were briefed on the terms of reference, roles and functions of the Committee and confidentiality.
2. Mr S K MOK was elected as the Chairperson of the Curriculum Development Council Committee on Mathematics Education (CDCC) for the term of office 2019-2021.
3. Members noted the minutes of the sixth meeting of the CDCC (2017 – 2019), that had been confirmed by the members of CDCC (2017 – 2019) without any amendments by email circulation.
4. The updating of Basic Competency (BC) Descriptors for Key Stage 1, Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 Mathematics Curriculum was reported. The arrangement of briefing seminars for school teachers on the updated BC Descriptors for KS1 Mathematics was also reported.
5. The progress of the preparation work of the Explanatory Notes to Mathematics Curriculum (Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3) was reported. It was reported that the drafts had been further revised with CDCC members' views incorporated.
6. The Task Force's initial recommendations on senior secondary Mathematics curriculum and some comments received and questions raised during consultation were reported and discussed.
7. The progress of the promotion of STEM education was reported and discussed.
