

Gist of First Meeting of the
CDC Committee on Physical Education (2017-2019)
held on 27 October 2017

1. The Secretary welcomed all members to the first meeting of the CDC Committee (CDCC) on Physical Education (PE) 2017 -19 and explained the terms of reference, roles and function of the CDCC on PE.
2. Mr CHAN King-tat was elected as the Chairperson of the CDCC on PE 2017 – 2019.
3. Members were briefed on three major focuses of the updated PE KLA Curriculum Guide, which were promotion of moderate-to-vigorous physical activities at least 60 minutes each day (MVPA 60) among students, enhancing the implementation of six strands in the PE curriculum and the development of Major Renewed Emphases (MRE) in PE. Members' views were noted.
4. Members were briefed on the recent curriculum development in PE and the support provided by the EDB, such as learning circles, professional development programmes, and learning and teaching resources.
5. Members were briefed on the benchmarking report of the Senior Secondary (SS) PE Elective. Members agreed to conduct a survey to collect teachers' views on the proposed update in SS PE curriculum.
