

**Gist of the Second Meeting of  
the CDC Committee on Physical Education (2017-2019) held on 11 June 2018**

1. Members were briefed on the updates of professional support, such as teacher networks and professional development programmes, provided by the PE Section in the 2017/18 school year.
2. Members were briefed on the recent curriculum development, especially on the strategies to promote MVPA60 and strengthen the implementation of Six Strands in the PE curriculum.
3. Members were briefed on the SS PE survey results and agreed that there was no need to change of the curriculum and assessment framework of Senior Secondary (SS) PE Elective at this moment. Members agreed the recommendations and noted that the practical examination of athletics and swimming, only taking into account the result performance of the candidates, would be effective from 2019.
4. Members were briefed on the issue concerning the shortage of the allocation of PE lesson time in some schools.
