

**Gist of the First Meeting of the
CDC Committee on Physical Education (2019-2021)
held on 9 October 2019**

1. The Secretary welcomed all members to the first meeting of the CDC Committee (CDCC) on Physical Education (PE) 2019-2021 and explained the terms of reference, roles and function of the CDCC on PE.
2. Mr CHAN King-tat was elected as the Chairperson of the CDCC on PE 2019 – 2021.
3. Members were briefed on the progress of the survey study of students' physical fitness and their attitudes towards PE (secondary schools). An updated norm tables on secondary school students' physical fitness would be developed and uploaded to the PE Website.
4. Members were briefed on the support measures to be provided by the EDB in this school year, such as teachers' networks, professional development programmes, professional exchange channels, learning and teaching resources, and other support measures in collaboration with other bureaux/departments.
5. Members were briefed on the initial recommendations of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum. Members agreed to the six initial recommendations.
6. Members were briefed and discussed on the feasibility of providing a certificate of results by students taking part in the HKSSF/ HKAAA/ HKASA for the exemption of the related events in HKDSE PE Paper 3. Members supported the proposal.
