

CDC Committee on Science Education (2019-2021)

Gist of Second Meeting

Date of meeting: 20 August 2020

1. The minutes of the first meeting of CDC Committee on Science Education (2019-2021) held on 26 November 2019 were confirmed without any amendment.
2. The impact of COVID-19 on learning and teaching of science were reported and discussed. The problems encountered and good practices on the learning and teaching during the suspension of classes collected from Focus Group Meetings were shared.
3. The suggested amendments on the reference list of furniture and equipment for subjects of Science KLA were reported and discussed.
4. The progress and supportive measures for promoting STEM education in secondary schools and primary schools were reported and discussed. Details about support measures for promoting STEM education, including the progress of the Intensive Training Programme (ITP) on STEM education for curriculum leaders and middle managers, as well as the new round of Intensive Training Programme for STEM coordinators and frontline teachers, were reported. In addition, the STEM-related activities held by the Science Museum were also reported.
5. Members were briefed on the general comments of HKDSE papers of Science subjects.
6. The support measures for each subject in Science Education Key Learning Area, including the development of learning and teaching resources, Professional Development Programmes for teachers, and related student activities were reported.
