

CDC-HKEAA Committee on Chemistry (2015-2017)
Gist of the 3rd Meeting

Date of meeting: 10-6-2016

Salient points of the discussion:

1. The results of the interim survey on the implementation of the updated Chemistry and Combined Science (Chemistry Part) were reported and discussed. In response to the concerns raised by the respondents of the survey, members put forward suggestions and views, such as reminding teachers to refer to the learning objectives/outcomes and the supplementary notes of the curriculum for interpreting the depth and breadth of topics, facilitating communication between chemistry and mathematics teachers so as to enhance students' learning in topics involving mathematical skills, and introducing to teachers the suggestions for curriculum planning given in the curriculum guides.
2. Aims and tentative schedule for a learning study in Chemistry were discussed. Members suggested topics to be studied, including mole calculation, electrolysis, redox reactions and rate of reaction.
