

CDC-HKEAA Committee on Chemistry (2019-2021)
Gist of the 1st Meeting

Date of meeting: 04-11-2019

Salient points of the discussion:

1. The terms of office, roles and functions of the committee were explained to members and their attention was drawn to issues related to confidentiality and publicity, as well as conflict of interest.
2. An election was conducted. Mr Ng Ka Wo of Hong Kong Taoist Association The Yuen Yuen Institute No. 3 Secondary School was elected the Chairperson of the Committee.
3. The views collected from teachers on the implementation of the Combined Science (Chemistry Part) curriculum and Elective Part of the Chemistry Curriculum were reported and discussed. Members' views on the implementation of the Combined Science (Chemistry Part) curriculum were collected.
4. A range of support measures for enhancing learning, teaching and assessment of Chemistry and Combined Science (Chemistry Part) were presented and discussed.
5. The implementation of the support measures for promoting STEM education in schools was reported.
6. Candidates' performance in the 2019 HKDSE Examination for Chemistry and Combined Science (Chemistry Part) was discussed.
