

Joint meeting between CDC-HKEAA Committee on Technology and Living (2013-2015) and HKDSE Technology and Living Subject Committee 2013/2014

Date of meeting: 18 June 2014

Key issues raised/discussed

- The principles underlying the review of SBA and the time line for medium-term review were presented.
- Members agreed that the key learning outcomes and skills assessed in Technology & Living (TL) SBA were essential for student's learning and could not be assessed in the form of written examination
- Members shared their observations on piloting of the TL SBA arrangement organised by HKEAA
- Members were informed that teachers' views on the implementation of SBA would be collected in the school survey in late 2014.
- The Meeting recommended to implement TL SBA in 2019
- The assessment design to be implemented starting from 2016 cohort was proposed as following:
