

CDC-HKEAA Committee on Mathematics Education (2015 – 2017)
Gist of the Fourth Meeting

Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. The progress of the updating of Mathematics Education KLA Curriculum Guide (KLACG) was reported and discussed. The term “mathematical skills”, as a generic skill which would be adopted in different KLAs, was discussed. Adopting mathematical skills as one of the generic skills was welcomed because it could help highlight the importance of Mathematics. The time frame for finalising KLACG was reported.
2. The progress of the review of Mathematics curriculum (P1 – S6) was reported and discussed. Changes suggested by Ad Hoc Committees were discussed. The table of Learning Units of primary Mathematics and M1, the suggested changes in Learning Units and Learning Objectives of M2, and suggested Learning Units of the possible Mathematics elective (MX) were endorsed. The suggested changes in Learning Units and learning objectives of KS3 Mathematics and the Compulsory Part, and the order of Learning Units in MX would be discussed in the next meeting.
