

CDC-HKEAA Committee on Mathematics Education (2015 – 2017) Gist of the Sixth Meeting

Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. The progress of the review of Mathematics curriculum was reported and the feedback collected from focus group meetings with teachers and members of professional bodies, meetings with academic members of universities and IVE, consultation forums with principals and teachers, questionnaire survey, and written submission during the public consultation period were discussed.
2. The contents of revised Mathematics curriculum (P1 – S6) recommended by Ad Hoc Committees (AHC), with the updates after the last AHC meetings, were discussed and endorsed.
3. The framework of senior secondary Mathematics curriculum was discussed and recommendation was made.
4. The implementation plan of the revised Mathematics curriculum (P1 – S6) was discussed and recommendation for further discussion and endorsement in CDCC was made. The arrangement for the transition period was discussed.
5. The strategies to cater for learner diversity at senior secondary level were discussed.
6. The progress on promoting STEM education was reported.
